Directions

From Interstate 80, exit 224, Danville, take route 54 east to 11 south; from exit 210A, Lewisburg, take route 15 south.

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike, exit 236, follow routes 11 and 15 north; from exit 242, follow route 83 north to routes 11 and 15; from exit 247, follow routes 283 and 83 north/322 west to routes 11 and 15 north.

From routes 11 and 15 north and south, follow signs to downtown Selinsgrove and Susquehanna University

From the North

- When 11&15 merge, you will continue south onto "the strip" (a stretch of highway marked by numerous businesses, gas stations, restaurants, etc.) You will go through 2 lights at the Monroe Marketplace where you'll see signs for Target, Kohl's, etc.
- Continue south past the Susquehanna Valley Mall (on your right) and further down, Sheetz convenience store (on your left)
- Go straight through the light where you see Sheetz
- You will cross over a small green bridge, and need to bear immediate Right onto Route 522
- Go straight through the traffic light (see Weis Markets on your left) and continue up the hill
- At the top of the hill, turn Left onto 18th St. where you see Susquehanna Bank on your left (Amato's restaurant will be on your right)
- Continue all the way down 18th St.
- When you come to the 4-way stop, go straight and you'll be on Susquehanna's campus
- The Degenstein Campus Center will be straight ahead (slightly left)
- Park in the lower lot marked for "Visitors"
- Come in the doors labeled Degenstein Center and continue walking to the end of the hall
- The Meeting Rooms will be on your right

From the South

- When you exit from Rte. 11 for Susquehanna University/Selinsgrove, you will turn Right at the end of the exit ramp
- Continue into town... you will come to a traffic light where Kinfolks Restaurant is on your right and First National Bank is on your left. TURN LEFT at this light onto Pine St.
- You will come to a stop sign, go straight.
- You'll begin to head uphill and will see campus on your left
- At the next stop sign (4-way stop, intersection w/ 18th St. and campus), turn LEFT into campus
- The Degenstein Campus Center will be straight ahead (slightly left)
- Park in the lower lot marked for "Visitors"
- Come in the doors labeled Degenstein Center and continue walking to the end of the hall
- The Meeting Rooms will be on your right
